



2016 Summer Reading **BOOKMARK CONTEST**

**Contest is open February 16
through March 31, 2016**

Eligibility

Children in grades K-12 who live or attend school in Clark, Skamania or Klickitat county, Yale Valley Library District or the Woodland School District may enter. Homeschoolers should enter at the comparable grade level.

Bookmarks will be judged on...

1. DESIGN

- Use this entry form or an exact photocopy of the same size. More forms are available at any FVRL location or at www.fvrl.org.
- **Design must incorporate the 2016 Summer Reading theme:
*On Your Mark, Get Set, READ!***
- Text may be in any language; words must be spelled correctly.
- **Keep important design details away from the line around the box or they may be cut off.**

2. ORIGINALITY

- Artwork must be original—no tracing or use of copyrighted images such as cartoon characters.
- Must be created by eligible K-12 contestant —no adult contributions.

3. REPRODUCIBILITY for printing

- Do not use lead (graphite) pencils.
- No computer-generated art.
- Do not use fluorescent markers.
- If you use crayons and/or colored pencils, press down to get solid colors (light sketching will not show up).

How to enter

- Complete your design inside the box provided.
- Be sure to completely fill out the information below – **PRINT CLEARLY!**
- One entry per person.
- **Entries must be received by Thursday, March 31 at an FVRL library or bookmobile.**
